## PROGRAM AREAS

### JACKSON TEEN ZONE (AGES 13-17)

The Teen Zone is a space exclusively for teens. Members enjoy the same luxuries of younger members while fostering community leadership, college prep and resume building skills.

### CADET ROOM (AGES 7-9)

The Cadet Room has many activities for the kids to participate in. Coloring contests, BINGO, Musical Chairs, 4 Corners, Simon says, Reading Time, Movie Time, Playing with Dolls and Legos!

### LEARNING CENTER (AGES 7-12)

Homework help and tutoring available. Learn about internet safety. Fun nutrition classes and play educational games.

### GYM (AGES 7-17)

Our beautiful 7,500 square foot gym is utilized for all sports activities: Survivor, Dodge Ball, Basketball, Relay Races, "Army, Navy, Marines," and Football, Basketball, & Soccer Intramural Leagues as well as club assemblies.

### INNOVATION LABS (AGES 9-17)

Youth use this space to learn and develop digital stories, 3D printing and other technical savvy skills.

### ART ROOM (Ages 7-12)

Come learn about the History of Art, participate in coloring contest, arts and crafts, making creative Pearle Beads. Have fun making Yarn Art, use sidewalk chalk, and learning new drawing skills.

### JR. GAMES ROOM (AGES 7-12)

Everyone loves the Jr. Games Room. There is a Carpet Ball, Bumper Pool, Air Hockey, Pool Tables, Foosball, Cup-stacking, Mancala, board games and Wii.

Throughout the day, we have recreational tournaments, and strategy competitions.

### TWEEN ROOM (AGES 10-12)

The Tween Room is an area where pre-teens can come and have a space of their own. They can play games, watch movies, have fun making arts and crafts projects, play bumper pool or the PS4 and we also have programs that are geared for the tweens.

### CLUB ROOMS 1, 2, 3 (AGES 7-17)

These rooms are for serving snacks and used for special programs.

## LEADERSHIP PROGRAMS

### AWESOME LITTLE HELPERS (AGES 7-9)

Character & Leadership program engages in service projects and mentoring other club members.

### TORCH CLUB (AGES 10-12)

Character & Leadership program based on volunteering and community engagement. Members will also serve as mentors to younger members.

### KEYSTONE (Ages 13-17)

Youth participate in activities in three focus areas; academic success, career preparation and community service.





## SPECIAL PROGRAMS

### POWER HOUR (AGES 7 - 12)

Homework help or educational games after school from 3:00 - 5:00 p.m. in the learning center.

### GET CITY (AGES 9 - 17)

GET City (Green Energy and Technology in the City) offers STEM-rich programming for youth grades 4 and up. As an innovative program vested in social justice, GET Citizens engage in coding, making, and forensics throughout the week.

### TAEKWONDO (AGES 7 - 17)

A program that teaches self-defense. You will learn about integrity, perseverance, self-control, & the indomitable spirit. The cost of the uniform is \$25.00, we pay for participation. Meets every Tuesday from 6:00 - 7:00 p.m.

### SMART MOVES (AGES 7 - 12)

Learn about making right choices. Learn who they can turn to in case of an emergency. Learn to build self-esteem and how to say no to drugs & alcohol.

### GIRL SCOUTS (AGES 7 - 12)

All girls can come together and participate in hands-on activities. Girl Scouts mission is to make sure every girl belongs.

A walking/running club where club members and coaches not only get fit but have fun doing so!

### CHEER & DANCE SKILLS CAMP (AGES 7 - 12)
